These terms and conditions of contract relate to sales by us to consumers only. Consumers are individuals acting for purposes which are wholly or mainly outside their trade, business, craft or profession. If you are buying from us wholly or mainly for the purposes of your trade, business, craft or profession then our B2B terms and conditions apply to our sale to you and not the terms set out below.

Our terms

- 1. These terms
- **1.1 What these terms cover**. These are the terms and conditions on which we supply products to you.
- **1.2 Why you should read them**. Please read these terms carefully before you submit your order to us. These terms tell you who we are, how we will provide products to you, how you and we may change or end the contract, what to do if there is a problem and other important information. If you think that there is a mistake in these terms, please contact us to discuss.
- 2. Information about us and how to contact us
- **2.1 Who we are.** We are Fulling Mill Limited a company registered in England and Wales. Our company registration number is 01740056 and our registered office is at 8 Fairlawn Enterprise Park, Bonehurst Road, Salfords, Surrey, RH1 5GH. Our registered VAT number is GB367525724.
- **2.2 How to contact us.** You can contact us by telephoning our customer service team at +44 (0)1293 778600 or by writing to us at <u>sales @fullingmill.com</u> or the above postal address.
- **2.3 How we may contact you.** If we have to contact you, we will do so by telephone or by writing to you at the email address or postal address you provided to us in your order.
- **2.4** "Writing" includes emails. When we use the words "writing" or "written" in these terms, this includes emails.
- 3. Our contract with you
- **3.1 How we will accept your order**. Our acceptance of your order will take place when we email you to accept it, at which point a contract will come into existence between you and us.
- **3.2 If we cannot accept your order**. If we are unable to accept your order, we will inform you of this in writing and will not charge you for the product. This might be because the product is out of stock, because of unexpected limits on our resources which we could not reasonably plan for or because we have identified an error in the price or description of the product.

- **3.3** Your order number. We will assign an order number to your order and tell you what it is when we accept your order. It will help us if you can tell us the order number whenever you contact us about your order.
- **3.4 We do not sell to the USA through this website**. Our website is solely for the promotion of our products outside the USA. If you are ordering products for delivery in the USA, please go to our sister website *www.fullingmill.com*.
- 3.5 Delivery of products outside of GB. If the delivery address for your order is not in GB, then it is your responsibility to ensure that our products can be imported into your country and that they are compliant with the laws of your country. We will not make any refund to you if your goods are not delivered because they do not clear the customs or other import authorities of your country. You must pay any import duties and other taxes on the products. If we are aware that one of our products cannot be sold in a specific country, then our website will prevent that sale taking place when you insert the delivery address. If the website does not prevent any given sale to a specific country, it does not mean that we guarantee that the products in question can legally be sold in and/or imported to that country.

4. Our products

- 4.1 Products may vary slightly from their pictures. The images of the products on our website are for illustrative purposes only. Although we have made every effort to display the colours accurately, we cannot guarantee that a device's display of the colours accurately reflects the colour of the products. Your product may vary slightly from those images. Although we have made every effort to be as accurate as possible, because our products are handmade, all sizes, weights, capacities, dimensions and measurements indicated on our website have a 5% tolerance.
- **4.2 Product packaging may vary**. The packaging of the product may vary from that shown in images on our website.

5. Your rights to make changes

If you wish to make a change to the product you have ordered, please contact us. We will let you know if the change is possible. If it is possible we will let you know about any changes to the price of the product, the timing of supply or anything else which would be necessary as a result of your requested change and ask you to confirm whether you wish to go ahead with the change. If we cannot make the change or the consequences of making the change are unacceptable to you, you may want to end the contract (see clause 8- Your rights to end the contract).

6. Our rights to make changes

6.1 Minor changes to the products. We may change the product:

- (a) to reflect changes in relevant laws and regulatory requirements; and
- (b) to implement minor technical adjustments and improvements, for example to address a security threat.

These changes will not affect your use of the product.

7. Providing the products

- **7.1 Delivery costs.** The costs of delivery will be as displayed to you on our website.
- **7.2 When we will provide the products**. We will deliver them to you as soon as reasonably possible. Please note the page on our website which gives detailed information on when we will provide the products http://www.fullingmill.co.uk/Support-UK/Delivery-UK.
- 7.3 We are not responsible for delays outside our control. If our supply of the products is delayed by an event outside our control, then we will contact you as soon as possible to let you know and we will take steps to minimise the effect of the delay. Provided we do this we will not be liable for delays caused by the event, but if there is a risk of substantial delay you may contact us to end the contract and receive a refund for any products you have paid for but not received.
- 7.4 If you are not at home when the product is delivered. If no one is available at your address to take delivery and the products cannot be posted through your letterbox, the delivery company will inform you of how to rearrange delivery or collect the products from a local depot.
- 7.5 If you do not re-arrange delivery. If you do not collect the products from us as arranged or if, after a failed delivery to you, you do not re-arrange delivery or collect them from a delivery depot the delivery company will contact you for further instructions and may charge you for storage costs and any further delivery costs. If, despite our reasonable efforts, we are unable to contact you or re-arrange delivery or collection we may end the contract and clause 10.2 will apply.
- 7.6 Your legal rights if we deliver goods late. You have legal rights if we deliver any goods late. If we miss the delivery deadline for any goods, then you may treat the contract as at an end straight away if any of the following apply:
 - (a) we have refused to deliver the goods;
 - (b) delivery within the delivery deadline was essential (taking into account all the relevant circumstances); or
 - (c) you told us before we accepted your order that delivery within the delivery deadline was essential.
- **7.7 When you become responsible for the goods**. The product will be your responsibility from the time we deliver the product to the address you gave us.

- **7.8** When you own goods. You own the goods once we have received payment in full.
- 8. Your rights to end the contract
- **8.1** You can always end your contract with us. Your rights when you end the contract will depend on what you have bought, whether there is anything wrong with it, how we are performing and when you decide to end the contract:
 - (a) If what you have bought is faulty or misdescribed you may have a legal right to end the contract (or to get the product repaired or replaced or to get some or all of your money back), see clause 11;
 - (b) If you want to end the contract because of something we have done or have told you we are going to do, see clause 8.2;
 - (c) If you have just changed your mind about the product, see clause 8.3. You may be able to get a refund if you are within the cooling-off period, but this may be subject to deductions and you will have to pay the costs of return of any goods;
 - (d) In all other cases (if we are not at fault and there is no right to change your mind), see clause 8.4.
- **8.2** Ending the contract because of something we have done or are going to do. If you are ending a contract for a reason set out at (a) to (d) below the contract will end immediately and we will refund you in full for any products which have not been provided and you may also be entitled to compensation. The reasons are:
 - (a) we have told you about an upcoming change to the product or these terms which you do not agree to (see clause **Error! Reference source not found.**);
 - (b) we have told you about an error in the price or description of the product you have ordered and you do not wish to proceed;
 - (c) there is a risk that supply of the products may be significantly delayed because of events outside our control;
 - (d) you have a legal right to end the contract because of something we have done wrong (including because we have delivered late (see clause 7.6).
- **8.3** Exercising your right to change your mind (Consumer Contracts Regulations 2013). For most products bought online you have a legal right to change your mind within 14 days and receive a refund. These rights, under the Consumer Contracts Regulations 2013, are explained in more detail in these terms.
- 8.4 Ending the contract where we are not at fault and there is no right to change your mind. Even if we are not at fault and you do not have a right to change your mind (see clause 8.1), you can still end the contract before it is completed, but you may have to pay us compensation. A contract for goods is completed when the product is delivered and paid for. If you want to end a

contract before it is completed where we are not at fault and you have not changed your mind, just contact us to let us know. The contract will end immediately and we will refund any sums paid by you for products not provided but we may deduct from that refund reasonable compensation for the net costs we will incur as a result of your ending the contract.

- 9. How to end the contract with us (including if you have changed your mind)
- **9.1 Tell us you want to end the contract**. To end the contract with us, please let us know by doing one of the following:
 - (a) Phone or email. Call customer services on +44 (0)1293 778600 or email us at <u>sales @fullingmill.com</u>. Please provide your name, home address, details of the order and, where available, your phone number and email address.
 - **(b) By post**. Simply write to us at 8 Fairlawn Enterprise Park, Bonehurst Road, Salfords, Surrey, RH1 5GH, including details of what you bought, when you ordered or received it and your name and address.
- 9.2 Returning products after ending the contract. If you end the contract for any reason after products have been dispatched to you or you have received them, you must return them to us. You must post them back to us at 8 Fairlawn Enterprise Park, Bonehurst Road, Salfords, Surrey, RH1 5GH. Please call customer services on +44 (0)1293 778600 or email us at sales@fullingmill.com for a return label. If you are exercising your right to change your mind you must send off the goods within 14 days of telling us you wish to end the contract.
- **9.3** When we will pay the costs of return. We will pay the costs of return:
 - (a) if the products are faulty or misdescribed; or
 - (b) if you are ending the contract because we have told you of an upcoming change to the product or these terms, an error in pricing or description, a delay in delivery due to events outside our control or because you have a legal right to do so as a result of something we have done wrong.

In all other circumstances (including where you are exercising your right to change your mind) you must pay the costs of return.

- **9.4 What we charge for collection**. If you are responsible for the costs of return and we are collecting the product from you, we will charge you the direct cost to us of collection. The costs of collection will be the same as our charges for standard delivery.
- **9.5 How we will refund you.** We will refund you the price you paid for the products including delivery costs, by the method you used for payment. However, we may make deductions from the price, as described below.

- **9.6 Deductions from refunds if you are exercising your right to change your mind.** If you are exercising your right to change your mind:
 - (a) We may reduce your refund of the price (excluding delivery costs) to reflect any reduction in the value of the goods, if this has been caused by your handling them in a way which would not be permitted in a shop. If we refund you the price paid before we are able to inspect the goods and later discover you have handled them in an unacceptable way, you must pay us an appropriate amount.
 - (b) The maximum refund for delivery costs will be the costs of delivery by the least expensive delivery method we offer. For example, if we offer delivery of a product within 3-5 days at one cost but you choose to have the product delivered within 24 hours at a higher cost, then we will only refund what you would have paid for the cheaper delivery option.
- 9.7 **When your refund will be made**. We will make any refunds due to you as soon as possible. If you are exercising your right to change your mind then your refund will be made within 14 days from the day on which we receive the product back from you or, if earlier, the day on which you provide us with evidence that you have sent the product back to us. For information about how to return a product to us, see clause 9.2.
- 10. Our rights to end the contract
- 10.1 **We may end the contract if you break it**. We may end the contract for a product at any time by writing to you if you do not, within a reasonable time, allow us to deliver the products to you or collect them from us.
- 10.2 You must compensate us if you break the contract. If we end the contract in the situations set out in clause 10.1 we will refund any money you have paid in advance for products we have not provided but we may deduct or charge you reasonable compensation for the net costs we will incur as a result of your breaking the contract.
- 11. If there is a problem with the product
- **11.1 How to tell us about problems**. If you have any questions or complaints about the product, please contact us. You can telephone our customer service team at +44 (0)1293 778600 or write to us at <u>sales@fullingmill.com</u> and 8 Fairlawn Enterprise Park, Bonehurst Road, Salfords, Surrey, RH1 5GH.
- **11.2 Summary of your legal rights.** We are under a legal duty to supply products that are in conformity with this contract. See the box below for a summary of your key legal rights in relation to the product. Nothing in these terms will affect your legal rights.

Summary of your key legal rights

This is a summary of your key legal rights. These are subject to certain exceptions. For detailed

information please visit the Citizens Advice website www.adviceguide.org.uk or call 03454 04 05 06.

The Consumer Rights Act 2015 says goods (such as flies) must be as described, fit for purpose and of satisfactory quality. During the expected lifespan of your product your legal rights entitle you to the following:

- a) Up to 30 days: if your goods are faulty, then you can get an immediate refund.
- b) Up to six months: if your goods can't be repaired or replaced, then you're entitled to a full refund, in most cases.
- c) Up to six years: if your goods do not last a reasonable length of time you may be entitled to some money back.

See also clause 8.3.

11.3 Your obligation to return rejected products. If you wish to exercise your legal rights to reject products, you must post them back to us. We will pay the costs of postage. Please call customer services on +44 (0)1293 778600 or email us at <u>sales @fullingmill.com</u> for a return label.

12. Price and payment

- **12.1** Where to find the price for the product. The price of the product (which includes UK VAT on sales to GB and NI addresses only) will be the price indicated on the order pages when you placed your order. We take all reasonable care to ensure that the price of the product advised to you is correct. However please see clause 12.3 for what happens if we discover an error in the price of the product you order.
- **12.2 We will pass on changes in the rate of VAT.** If the rate of VAT changes between your order date and the date we supply the product, we will adjust the rate of VAT that you pay, unless you have already paid for the product in full before the change in the rate of VAT takes effect.
- **12.3 What happens if we got the price wrong**. It is always possible that, despite our best efforts, some of the products we sell may be incorrectly priced. We will normally check prices before accepting your order so that, where the product's correct price at your order date is less than our stated price at your order date, we will charge the lower amount. If the product's correct price at your order date is higher than the price stated to you, we will contact you for your instructions before we accept your order.
- 12.4 **When you must pay and how you must pay**. We accept payment by the means detailed on www.fullingmill.co.uk. You must pay for the products before we dispatch them. We will not charge your credit or debit card until we dispatch the products to you.

- 13. Our responsibility for loss or damage suffered by you
- with these terms, we are responsible for loss or damage you suffer that is a foreseeable result of our breaking this contract or our failing to use reasonable care and skill, but we are not responsible for any loss or damage that is not foreseeable. Loss or damage is foreseeable if either it is obvious that it will happen or if, at the time the contract was made, both we and you knew it might happen, for example, if you discussed it with us during the sales process.
- 13.2 We do not exclude or limit in any way our liability to you where it would be unlawful to do so. This includes liability for death or personal injury caused by our negligence or the negligence of our employees, agents or subcontractors; for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; for breach of your legal rights in relation to the products as summarised at clause 11.2.
- **13.3** We are not liable for business losses. We only supply the products for domestic and private use. If you use the products for any commercial, business or re-sale purpose we will have no liability to you for any loss of profit, loss of business, business interruption, or loss of business opportunity.
- 14. How we may use your personal information
- 14.1 **How we may use your personal information**. We will only use your personal information as set out in our privacy policy http://www.fullingmill.co.uk/Support-UK/Privacy-Cookie-Policy-UK.
- 15. Other important terms
- **15.1 We may transfer this agreement to someone else.** We may transfer our rights and obligations under these terms to another organisation.
- **15.2 Nobody else has any rights under this contract.** This contract is between you and us. No other person shall have any rights to enforce any of its terms. Neither of us will need to get the agreement of any other person in order to end the contract or make any changes to these terms.
- 15.3 If a court finds part of this contract illegal, the rest will continue in force. Each of the paragraphs of these terms operates separately. If any court or relevant authority decides that any of them are unlawful, the remaining paragraphs will remain in full force and effect.
- 15.4 Even if we delay in enforcing this contract, we can still enforce it later. If we do not insist immediately that you do anything you are required to do under these terms, or if we delay in taking steps against you in respect of your breaking this contract, that will not mean that you do not have to do those things and it will not prevent us taking steps against you at a later date. For example, if you miss a payment and we do not chase you but we continue to provide the products, we can still require you to make the payment at a later date.

- 15.5 Which laws apply to this contract and where you may bring legal proceedings. These terms are governed by English law and you can bring legal proceedings in respect of the products in the English courts. If you live in Scotland, you can bring legal proceedings in respect of the products in either the Scottish or the English courts. If you live in Northern Ireland, you can bring legal proceedings in respect of the products in either the Northern Irish or the English courts.
- 15.6 **Alternative dispute resolution**. Please note that disputes may be submitted for online resolution to the European Commission Online Dispute Resolution platform http://ec.europa.eu/consumers/odr/.
